



### Percent of High School Students Currently Using Alcohol

#### Illicit Drug Use

Less than 10% of Vermont high school students report using any illicit drugs other than cannabis, same as national rate.


### Prescription Drug Misuse

9% of Vermont high school students report ever using a prescription pain medicine such as codeine, Vicodin, OxyContin, hydrocodone, and Percocet without a doctor's prescription or different from how a doctor told them to use it, more than 2% lower than national rates.



Community


