#### **Surveys and Primary Data Sources**

<u>National Survey on Drug Use and Health</u>: Federally run survey, completed annually, data available in December of the following year. State-level data aggregated into two-year intervals in order to reach a sufficient sample size. Data on all types of substance use, misuse and disorders. In addition, sub-state-level data are released in three year increments that cover four regions in Vermont. <u>http://healthvermont.gov/adap/clearinghouse/publications.aspx#NSDUH</u>

<u>Youth Risk Behavior Survey</u>: Federally funded survey run by the Health Department and asked of middle and high school students every other year in the odd years. Survey is paper and pencil. Survey covers a very wide variety of health topics including substance use and misuse. Data available at the county, health service area, Health District Office area and supervisory union levels. http://healthvermont.gov/research/yrbs.aspx

<u>Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System</u>: Federally funded survey run by the Health Department and asked of adults ages 18 and over every year via random telephone dial. Survey covers a very wide variety of health topics including alcohol use and misuse, prescription drug misuse and marijuana use. <u>http://healthvermont.gov/research/brfss/brfss.aspx</u>

<u>Substance Abuse Treatment Information System</u>: State run data collection system for all preferred providers funded through the Health Department Alcohol and Drug Abuse Programs. Data available by substance, county and age. These are the data used to upload to the national TEDs database. <u>http://healthvermont.gov/adap/clearinghouse/publications.aspx#top</u>

<u>College Health Survey</u>: The Vermont College Health Survey is administered every other year (even years) to students in participating institutions of higher learning. The survey covers several areas of behavioral health including substance use and abuse. This survey was implemented in 2014 and those results are still being processed. The next survey will be administered in the spring of 2016.



<u>Drug-Related Fatalities Data Brief</u>: Data brief on all drug-related fatalities that occur in Vermont. Data updated quarterly with a two to three month delay. <u>http://healthvermont.gov/research/documents/databrief\_drug\_related\_fatalities.pdf</u>
